SUBMISSION GUIDELINES for 2020

THEME

Loud and Luminous team wishes to promote an empowering message. The 2020 theme is **EQUALITY**. We want you to relate the theme to women and non-binary people. Reference this theme in iconography, pose, lighting, subject matter, in whatever method you want to, to give voice to your vision. It can be a portrait, object, abstract,

landscape etc. It does not matter what genre you photograph, we know that you can be inspired to make a wonderfully positive message in your image.

IMPORTANT IMAGE SUBMISSION SPECIFICATIONS

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS 31st October 2019

In 2020 all images will again be printed on the same size paper by our sponsor Kayell Australia and Canson. The Paper will be Canson Gold Fibre Photographique 310 gsm. Your image can be square to fit within that format and the image can be either landscape or portrait orientation. The printer will print all images with a white border. Square images will be printed with the image towards the top of the paper.

Your current CV PDF or Word doc named 'Surname-Initial-CV.doc' or Pdf
A Headshot 600pix by 600pix named 'Surname-Initial.jpg"
OPTIONAL but encouraged: 1 minute video statement, to be done in landscape format on your phone or camera.
